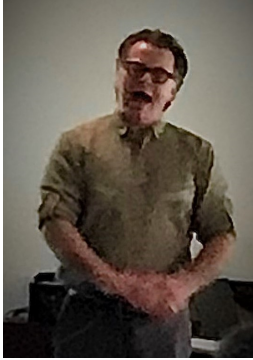

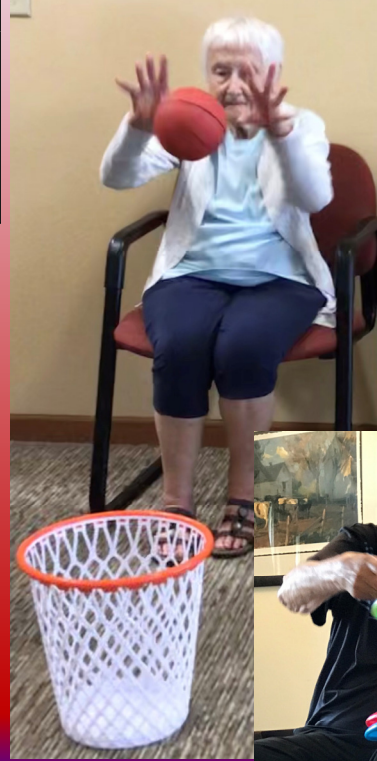
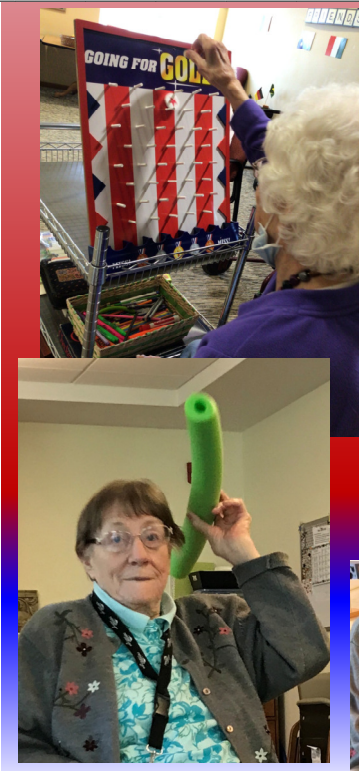


Village Olympics

Some resident at Newton Village wonder if I become their pastor since they are now here or if they can keep the pastor of their church. The answer is, "Yes".

As chaplain, I care for each resident and I am the liaison to community and county churches to keep people connected with their church. However, due to privacy laws, the residents or their families must notify their church that they live or are convalescing at a care center or hospital.

Pastors, priests, ministers, deacons, or other church servant titles are welcomed to visit and serve their parishioners here. Some bring communion for their people. When the county Covid infection rate is above 10% visits require a mask. Our Care Center also requires appointments in order to reduce risk of too many people in the facility.

Residents can watch their church online if that is offered and we will gladly assist when requested.
