I am very grateful for my education and continued training for almost 30 years of ministry. This month I have the opportunity to teach international pastors who have little access to Bible schooling. Some are appointed to be their church pastor simply because they can read.

Thankfully, ReachGlobal Pathways (pathwaytrainers.com) has developed a process of nine sessions over three years to equip pastors to accurately discover and communicate God's Word empowered by His Spirit. Each of these pastors also has pastors whom they train. Having completed my Pathways prep work, I am committed for two training camps near Delhi and near Calcutta, India from June 4-19. These two camps will have over 40 total pastor trainees.

This is not a vacation but a faith investment in God's Kingdom. Each challenge is more than I can handle naturally and I must trust God. So I ask for His and your gracious prayer support. Culture, communication, water, 100+ degree days, and rest will be constant challenges along with travel and logistics. Please pray for my humility, health and heart to share life in Jesus' name. I will give a trip summary when I return.
