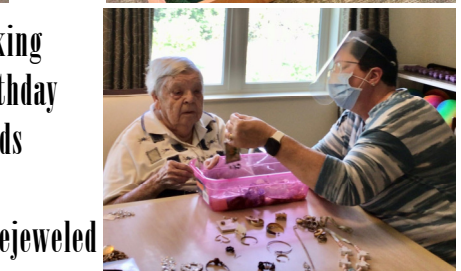

DV, Deo Volente, God willing. I have a friend who says or writes this when confirming plans. It annoys some people to invoke God's name and will into daily life. It can sound like a religious cliché, but for him it is a constant reminder that his plans are always subservient to God's. It's a practice of faith humility.

The Bible says in James 4:13 Look here, you who say, "Today or tomorrow we are going to a certain town and will stay there a year. We will do business there and make a profit." 14 How do you know what your life will be like tomorrow? Your life is like the morning fog—it's here a little while, then it's gone. 15 What you ought to say is, "If the Lord wants us to, we will live and do this or that." 16 Otherwise you are boasting about your own pretentious plans, and all such boasting is evil.

God expects people to make plans, but He warns against deception and arrogance that they can fully dictate their lives and outcomes apart from Him. The passage mentions annual plans (that guarantee profit), but no one even knows what will happen later today, overnight, or tomorrow. If we cannot control a short time frame, we certainly cannot control a year!

So the solution is to always surrender our plans to God's. We don't have to say, "God willing," but we do need to humbly practice submission to Him by challenging our motives, feelings, and thoughts in light of His gracious sovereignty. He always has something better for us than what we can come up with.
